


The Royal initiated Monkey's Cheek Project THE LAKE OF LOVE

This is the only one project undertaken by a private organization. Over and above this all necessary facilities which lead to the reservoir were built and leading to a pavilion by concrete roads. Electricity was put up. Water treatment and landscaping with more than 150 trees were planted. There are two children playgrounds overlooking the reservoir; and a concrete "Ta kror" court, etc. this project which ultimately will turn in to one of the tourist attractions in the North-east of country.

This tiny book tells how it all started by one common man to show the concrete concept of doing good to the country... one more example of what H.M. had done, and what we can do to show the LOVE the Thai people have in H.M the King.

I wish those who took part in this endeavor in the construction of... "THE LAKE OF LOVE" to whatever extent, will genuinely LOVE OUR KING as much as he LOVED all of us.
